## **Executive Summary of Planned Activities**

The Cystic Fibrosis Worldwide (CFW) Education Podcast Series I is based on CFW's well-established education program. Since inception in 2002, CFW has hosted a variety of conferences and workshops, which feature top medical and allied health professions who specialize in cystic fibrosis (CF).

With 67 member countries and numerous partnerships, CFW has been able to spread information to families, patients, and medical professionals. The Education Podcast Series I is designed to extend this effort by providing resources to those who may not normally have access to CFW's conferences and workshops. CFW will achieve this goal by making presentations available on the CFW website and iTunes. Many medical professionals lack the time and money needed to travel to educational conferences, but most professionals have internet access. Also, data indicates that approximately 43% of physicians own an iPod or similar mp3 device.\*

In addition to increased availability due to internet access, CFW will make pertinent information about CF available to a broad audience by offering the presentations in multiple languages, English and Spanish. In the US, Hispanic patients face difficulty due to the inability to communicate effectively with medical and allied health professionals as well as the CF community. It has been found that 64% of US patients with limited English speak Spanish.\*\* In addition, Hispanic children make up 33.1% of children living in poverty in the US, which increases the concerns for adequate health care and information. The Spanish translations will not only be available to Spanish-speaking medical and allied health professionals but also Spanish-speaking patients and families. Informed medical professionals are only half of the equation. Patients and their caregivers need to be knowledgeable of treatment options and healthy habits to improve their health.

In addition to accessibility, the Education Podcast Series I offers an innovative approach to education. The program allows medical and allied health professionals, as well as patients and families, to access quality educational materials from the comfort of their own home. Not only are participants able to access the information from a computer anywhere in the world, but they are also able to download the information and take it with them to view at their own leisure. The mp3 format allows participants to listen to the presentations without being stuck in a classroom or in front of a computer. According to The Pearson Foundation, 61% of community college students have taken an online course.\*\*\* Distance learning is in demand, and medical and allied health professionals, as well as patients and families, need access to education that fits their busy schedules and tight budgets.
